Loudoun County Sanitation Authority (DBA Loudoun Water), the Owner, invites qualified contractors to submit a single sealed Bid for the aforementioned project. The Project generally consists of approximately 8,200 linear feet of 30-inch diameter waterline from Pacific Boulevard westward, along the W&OD Trail, then northward on Route 607. The Project also includes some additional 16-inch sanitary sewer, 10-inch waterline, and approximately 650 linear feet of 12-inch waterline west of Route 607 and north of Gloucester Parkway. The complete scope of Work can be found in the Bidding Documents.

Sealed Bids will be received at the Owner's office until 2:00 P.M. local time, November 15, 2011, at which time they will be opened and read aloud. Bids received after the date and time given below will be returned to the Bidder unopened. The procurement process and the performance of the Contract shall be governed by the provisions of the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA).
