



HYDRANT RESTRICTION DISCLOSURE NOTICE

AREA OF AUTHORIZED USE:

Loudoun Water hydrant meters are to be used only on yellow hydrants within Loudoun Water's service area. This is generally defined as the area east of Goose Creek to the Fairfax County line. Loudoun Water's service area DOES NOT include the entire county. Loudoun Water hydrant meters MAY NOT BE USED in any of Loudoun County's incorporated towns, such as Leesburg, Purcellville, Hamilton, Round Hill, Lovettsville, and Middleburg, or outside the boundary of Goose Creek and the Fairfax County line. Loudoun Water hydrant meters MAY NOT BE USED in any of the following areas:

Any future village and/or hamlet community served by a groundwater well will also be restricted from hydrant meter usage. Contact us at anytime for an updated list or go to www.LoudounWater.org.

Loudoun Water hydrant meters are to be used only with yellow hydrants within Loudoun Water's service area. Red fire hydrants are restricted for use by the local fire departments and Loudoun Water personnel. Please review the attached list of these yellow fire hydrant locations. If your company is working on an active construction project, the development company responsible for that project determines which fire hydrants will be yellow until the project is finalized by Loudoun Water, and then all fire hydrants within that development must be painted red, unless otherwise specified by Loudoun Water personnel.

Using Loudoun Water hydrant meters in any of the County's towns, villages, hamlet communities, or anywhere outside Loudoun Water's service area is considered theft and can result in fines and prosecution by the jurisdictional authorities. You will be fined \$250 by Loudoun Water if found using Loudoun Water meters outside our service area, on red fire hydrants, or for improper hydrant meter use.
